Hatsingimari College Innovation Council

The Innovation Council of Hatsingimari College inspires, encourages, and nurtures young students by supporting them to work with new ideas and transform them into prototypes in their formative years. Innovation and Start up Policy has been framed by the institute. Various programmes on Start-up, IPR, entrepreneurship development in Higher Education Institute, idea competitions, industry visit etc. are organised to inculcate entrepreneurship culture among students. The students participated all these programmes actively.

Research and Publication Cell

with the aim to inculcate research culture and attitude amongst students and the teachers, the college has established **Research and Publication cell**. The cell organizes seminars, workshops, lectures and webinars on various issues, both in-house and by inviting speakers. Moreover, the cell organizes Faculty Seminar to discuss the research works of the faculties with the peers. The cell framed the *Code of Ethics to check malpractices and plagiarism in Research* for the institute for the college.

The outcomes of these cells are as follows.

Presently 10 faculty members have been awarded Ph. D. degree.

College plans to organise National Level seminars sponsored by UGC, ICPR and ICHR. Students are always influenced to participate and submit abstracts in the research programme, for which students are time to time trained to write abstract or dissertation with scientific attitude.

Career Counselling and Placement Cell

Career Counselling and Placement Cell in collaboration with various Government and Private organisation organises various activities, lectures on Softskill and Personality, entrepreneurship development, Career opportunities and workshop on Public speaking skill coaching in competitive examinations etc. The Cell not only guide the students of this college but also to students from other institution.

Skill Based Add on Courses

The institute has initiated various skill-based Add-on courses like Spoken English, Domestic Circuit Design, Pond Water Quality Management, Small Scale Vermi Composting, Gardening Tips, Ornamental Fish and Fisheries, Integrated Fish farming, Agro Preneurship, Chemistry in Pisciculture, Assam History for Competitive Examinations etc. to provide them with a first-hand experience in those areas.

Students clubs

Establishment of various Students clubs, like Music, Debate, Drama, Sports, Dance, Quiz, Creative writing, Literary, , Art & Drawing, Mathematics, Electronics and Photography facilitates students to develop their interests in various fields.

The NSS and NCC Cell of the College often club the students and make them involved in various activities.

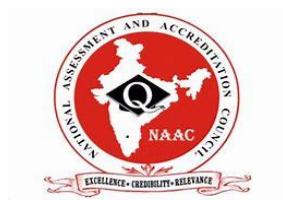

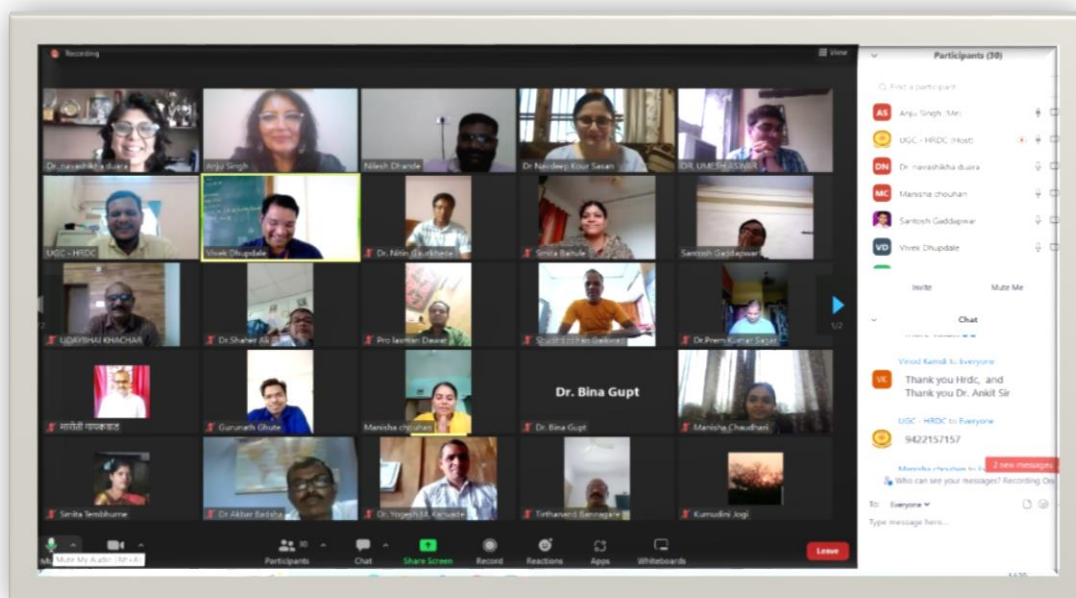
