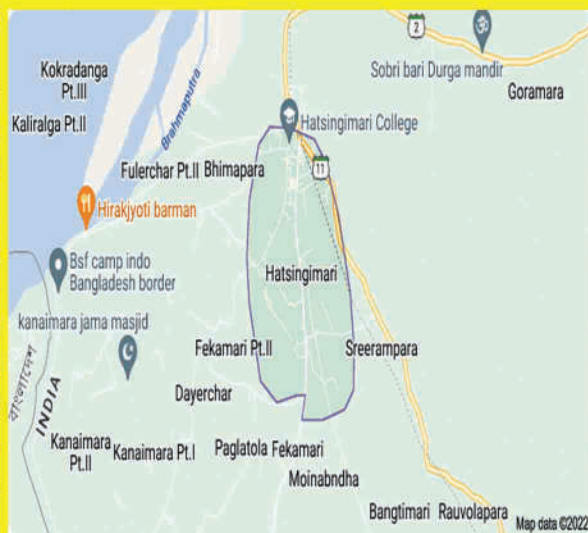

The District is situated in the South Bank of the mighty river Brahmaputra constituting plains, chars, river valleys and hilly areas. The district is bounded by Indo-Bangla international Border to the west, Assam-Meghalaya inter-state Border to the east and south and Dhubri District to the North .The district has two revenue circles, namely, South Salmara and Mankachar Revenue Circles comprising 35 numbers of Gaon Panchayat with three Community Development Blocks identifying itself as a rural district. The district head quarter is 245 km south west away from the state capital city Guwahati

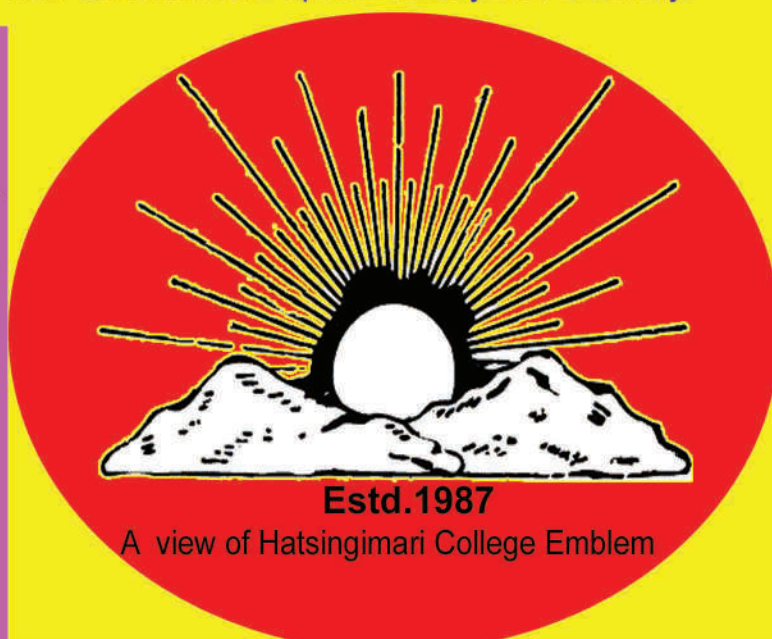

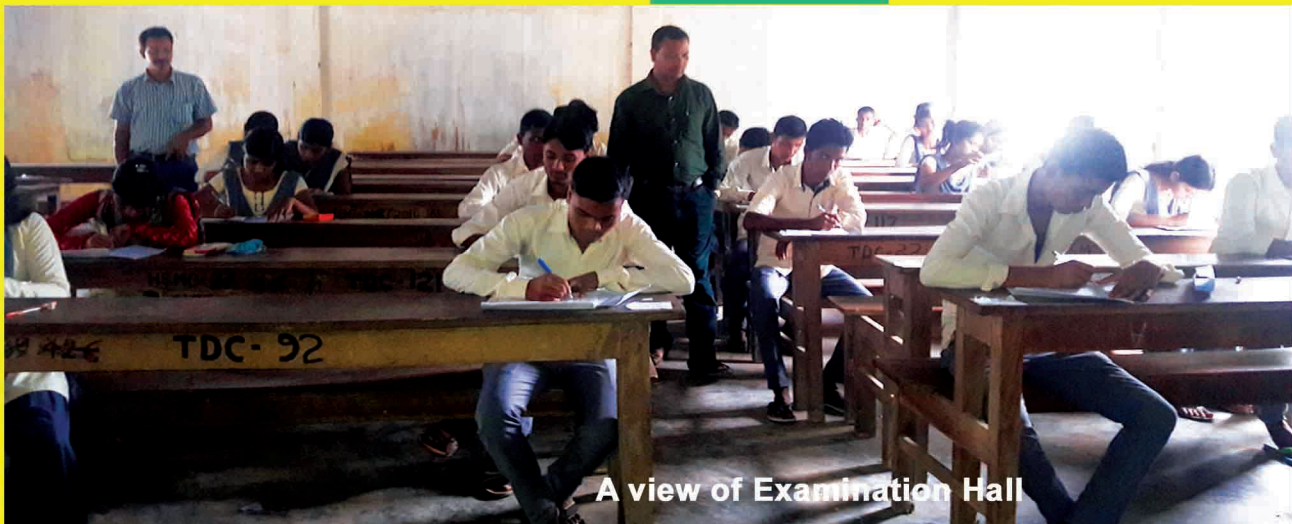
Internal Assessments is held in the college as per academic calendar for each semester conducted by the department concerned.

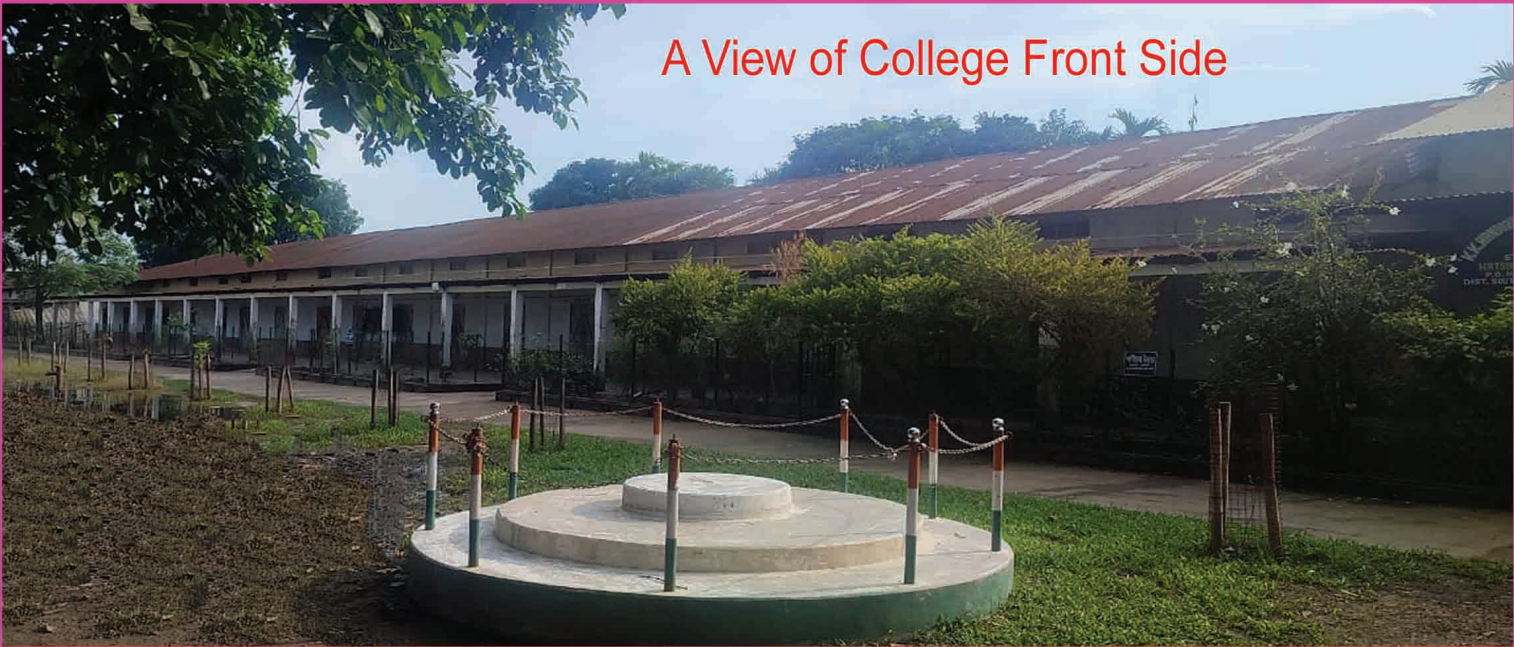
